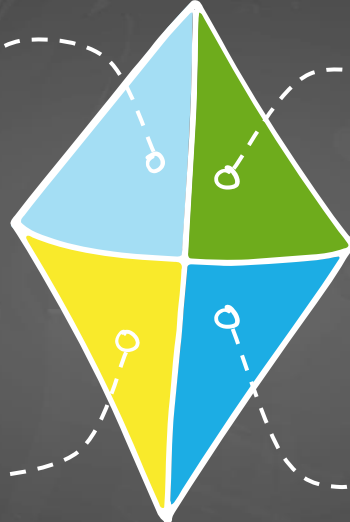

Eden Park is especially dedicated to children & young people and all those who are going through difficult times, with the aim to restore hope.



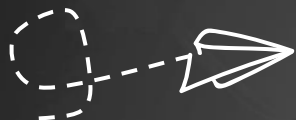

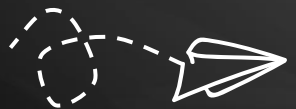
